Position Overview:

We are seeking a seasoned Mountain Maintenance Manager to oversee all aspects of mountain operations, including snowmaking, snow cat operations, trail maintenance, and general ski area operations. This is a hands-on leadership role requiring extensive technical expertise and a passion for mountain recreation. You will be responsible for ensuring that the facilities operate safely, smoothly, especially during peak winter months, in alignment with Panadero Ski Corporation's mission of providing affordable, family-friendly year-round recreation experiences.

Key Responsibilities:

- Oversee the daily operations of ski mountain maintenance, including snowmaking systems, snow cat operations, and lift maintenance.
- Perform and supervise routine inspections and repairs on all equipment to ensure compliance with safety standards, particularly OSHA regulations.
- Coordinate snowmaking efforts to ensure optimal skiing conditions throughout the season.
- Operate heavy machinery, including snowcats and other equipment, for trail grooming and mountain maintenance.

- Lead a small team, while also working independently during overnight shifts to maintain ski trails and systems.
- Collaborate with the PSC board and community volunteers to support Panadero's mission of restoring Cuchara Mountain Park as a sustainable and inclusive year-round outdoor recreation destination.

Requirements:

Must reside in Cuchara Colorado and be able to get to the park during and after snow storms.

Minimum 10 years of experience in ski area maintenance.

Minimum 10 years of experience in snowcat operations and snowmaking systems.

Heavy equipment operation experience required.

Must be a self-starter, comfortable working long hours and managing maintenance tasks with minimal supervision.

OSHA 10 certified.

Must be willing to work overnight shifts regularly during the ski season.
